## Global Mental Health

According to WHO's estimates globally 1 out of every 4 people will be impacted by poor mental health or mental illness at some point in their lives. In high-income countries, 5 out of 10 people that require mental health (MH) or psychosocial support (PSS) cannot access the care they need. In low- and middle-income countries, this number rises to 9 out of 10 people. This webinar is a follow-up to 2020 fourth edition of MTb on Global Mental Health, and takes place before the NVTG symposium on 22 January also focusing on GMH.

In the webinar, chaired by Hans Rode, a number of the contributing authors will provide more detail on their articles, and discuss topical issues in global mental health. The participants are expected to read the latest issue of MTb on Global Mental Health that can be found at:
